SUBJECT: REVISION OF MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 03-04-85 RE: PROGRAM STANDARDS

Pursuant to the powers vested upon the National Telecommunications Commission, the Program Standards Promulgated by this Commission under Memorandum Circular No, 03-04-85 is hereby amended to include new paragraphs "5" and "6" to item C page three of said Standards, as follows:

- "5" All radio broadcasting and television stations shall provide adequate public service time; shall conform to the ethics of honest enterprise; and shall not use its stations for the broadcasting and/or telecasting of obscene or indescent language, speech, play, act, or scene or for the dissemination of false information or willful misrepresentation, or to the detriment of the public health or to incite encourage, or assist in subversive or treasonable acts.
- "6" All radio broadcasting and television stations shall, during any broadcast or telecast, cut off from the air the speech, play, act or scene or other matter being broadcast and/or telecast, if the tendency thereof is to propose and/or incite treason, rebellion or sedition, or the language used therein or the theme thereof is indecent or immoral.
