MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 26-89

SUBJECT: MODIFICATION OF FREQUENCY ALLOCATION RELATING TO THE USE OF THE BAND 136-137 MHz BY THE AERONAUTICAL MOBILE (R) SERVICE

Pursuant to Act No. 3846 as amended, Executive Order No. 546 and the ITU Radio Regulations and in conformity with the internationally approved plans for that service for the purpose of public safety in air navigation. Recommendation No. 404 of the ITU Radio Regulations is hereby implemented as follows:

- 1. All stations in the Fixed Service, Mobile Service except Aeronautical Mobile (R) Service, the Space Operation Service (Space-to-Earth) operating or intending to operate in the band 136-137 MHz shall after January 01, 1990 take all possible steps to give the required protection to the Aeronautical Mobile (R) Service.
- 2. All stations of the Fixed and Mobile except Aeronautical Mobile (R) Services to which the band is allocated on secondary basis shall cease operation as and when the station of the Aeronautical Mobile (R) Service come into operation.
- 3. Existing stations of the Fixed and Mobile except Aeronautical Mobile (R) Services shall be transferred to appropriate VHF or UHF bands on or before January 01, 1990.

This circular shall take effect immediately. All other circulars contrary hereto are deemed superseded.
